Our prayers are with all our engaged couples and baptism candidates, and their families, and especially with those who are bereaved. Most will now be opening, and weddings are permitted by the government, but what is possible within a service is limited by strict regulations. We are currently planning for baptisms; there is likely to be a lengthy waiting list. Funerals will usually be held at the graveside or in the crematorium, with limited attendance, although funerals are now possible inside churches. Funerals are arranged through your funeral director, but anybody on the ministry team (listed above) would be happy to talk if you need to. For the time being there will be no 'Open Vestry Hour'. We look forward to fully marking these important milestones in the Christian journey more fully as soon as possible.
